Editorial in a high school newspaper

Several years after the COVID-19 pandemic, people are traveling more, and domestic and international trips are happening again. In high schools in Japan, this has become a big event, and some schools are organizing overseas study trips. However, did you know that some students do not go on these trips and stay at school to study on their own? There are families who are against overseas study trips.

First of all, the cost of the trips is too high. Due to rising fuel costs from international conflicts, increased hotel prices because of travelers from Asia, and the weak Japanese Yen, the cost is two to three times more than domestic trips. Most families cannot afford to pay that much. Furthermore, the safety of the destination can be affected by global events, which can lead to sudden changes in the destination or even cancellation of the trip, depending where you are going. This uncertainty is another concern for families.

On the other hand, many families support overseas study trips. They believe that experiencing other countries' cultures, customs, and history helps students understand different cultures better. It also gives them a chance to think more about their own country. Additionally, through exchange programs between schools, students can improve their language skills and build relationships. This experience can help them grow with a global perspective in the future.

In conclusion, overseas study trips have both advantages and disadvantages, and the decision should not be based solely on the cost. As middle school students choose which high school they want to attend, the destination of the study trip also becomes a concern for parents.
